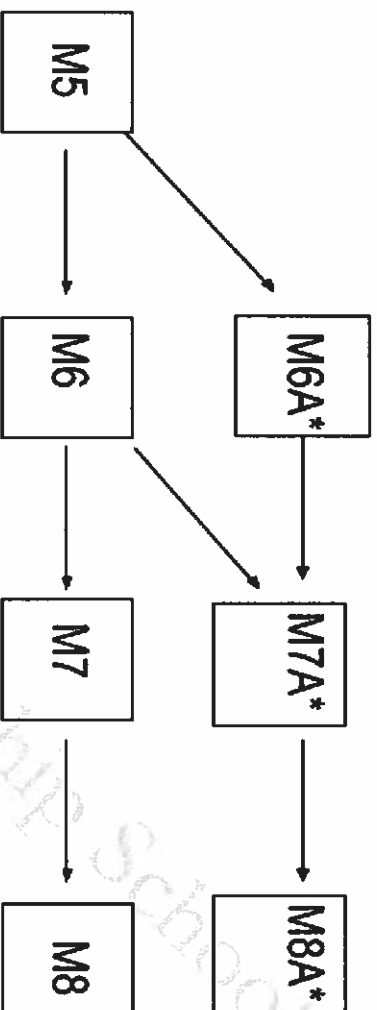

- B. Grade 6 students who have completed Math 6 will have the following option(s) based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 7
 - b. Math 7A (Pre-Algebra)
- C. Grade 7 students who have completed Math 7 will have the following option based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 8 (Pre-Algebra)
- D. Grade 7 students who have completed Math 7A will have the following option based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 8A (Algebra)
