## **Spring Fly Fishing Workshop**

Bedminster Recreation is teaming up with the New Jersey Audubon Scherman Hoffman Wildlife Sanctuary to offer a Fly Fishing Workshop over Spring Break for children in 4th to 8th grade on Tuesday, April 4 and Thursday, April 6 from 12pm—1pm at River Road Park in Bedminster. This is a two part introduction to fly fishing. No experience is necessary. This workshop is suitable for beginner to intermediate fly fishermen. You are encouraged to bring your own fly rod & reel, but loaner equipment will be available for use at the program. This is an instructional workshop only, no actual fishing will be done. **Registration ends Friday, March 31.** 

Day 1 of the workshop covers the differences between fly tackle and conventional tackle, fly casting mechanics, casting techniques for varied situations, and proper tackle care. Day 2 of the workshop reinforces skills learned in Workshop 1, while also addressing stream ecology, fly selection, fishing approach, and stream stewardship. Workshop leader Angus Macaulay is a Teacher/Naturalist for NJ Audubon and a fly fisherman with years of experience fishing around the world.
