

REGISTRATION:

Registration will open on April 1st. You can register online with a credit card at <https://register.communitypass.net/Bedminster> or return the registration forms with a check payable to "Bedminster Recreation" to One Miller Lane, Bedminster, NJ 07921.

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

PAYMENT:

Payment is to be made in full at the time of registration by check payable to "Bedminster Recreation", cash or credit card. There is no pro-rating for missed classes.

REFUNDS:

Refunds will be granted if a program is cancelled by the Recreation Department and no cancellation fee will be assessed. Program registration fees are refundable if you cancel at least five (5) business days prior to the start of the program with a \$10 cancellation fee assessed. Refunds will not be issued if the request is made less than five (5) business days before the start of the program or after the program start date. If you do not show up for a program, there is no credit to allow you to participate in another program.

CAMP BEDMINSTER

June 26 – August 11

(7 Week Program – Entering Grades 1 to 7)

Now in our 44th year! Camp Bedminster offers terrific and safe summer fun for children entering Grades 1 to 7! Camp Bedminster is a half day summer camp held in the Bedminster School from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm, Monday through Friday for seven (7) consecutive weeks beginning June 26 through August 11.

Before Care is available for an additional fee beginning at 7:45 am. If you are looking for an extended day program, offered separately is our **Lunch Bunch Program** which is a supervised “bring your own lunch”/ recess program, followed by a variety of week-long **Afternoon Camps from 1 to 4 pm**. For a complete list and detail about afternoon camps visit our website at www.bedminster.us and click on “Township Services” on the navigation bar, then “Recreation Programs”.

Camp Bedminster activities include simple Arts & Crafts, Sports, Cooking, Traditional Games, Discovery Sciences, and Musical activities. Additional activities include Camp Olympics, theme days, group skits, and field trips. Campers are divided into groups by grade and supervised by Counselors and Counselors-In-Training (CITs) with specialists teaching the main activity areas. You can choose either a three (3) day or five (5) day camp option. The 5-day option includes field trips which are scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The 3-Day option meets Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays only and the children do not attend the trips. Tuition assistance is available.

We are offering three (3) sessions of Camp Bedminster in either the 3 or 5 day format OR you can choose the entire seven (7) week option (at a discounted rate). This format requires a great deal of coordination therefore we are asking that you register early and on time as registration may not be available after June 9th. The options are as follows:

Travelin' Teens provides a week-long of afternoon fun for campers entering 6th to 9th grade in the fall of 2023! There are three (3) sessions to choose from. Supervised by Camp Bedminster Director Mr. Randy Backer and Bedminster School Teacher Mr. Tom Notte, campers will travel to a different action packed summer venue each day. Transportation will be provided to and from each location, and will depart from the Bedminster School parking lot daily. For lakes, pools and waterparks participants will need to bring a bathing suit, towel, change of clothes and sunscreen. Additional spending money is suggested for venues with snack bars and concessions stands.

Signed waivers are required for participation at some of our venues, and will be mailed after June 9th. The cost of the Travelin' Teens Day Trip program is \$350 for the week.

This summer we are offering two sessions of our super popular Farm Camp at *Ort Farms!* Farm Camp at *Ort Farms* (Est. 1863), located at 25 Bartley Road in Long Valley, is the ultimate camp experience, combining farm education and sustainable living on a working farm. Farm campers will learn about farming through various nature-based activities including planting, growing and harvesting; as well as environmental factors that impact crops and ultimately the farm business. Campers will have the opportunity to interact with farm animals, learn how to feed and care for them, and understand their importance on a sustainable farm.

Camp will be taught by Ort family members and supervised by Camp Bedminster Director Randy Backer and other camp staff. **Transportation will be provided from Camp Bedminster to the farm daily. Parents are to pick up promptly at 4 pm at Bedminster School.** Please be sure to dress comfortably and appropriately for a day outdoors (e.g. hat, sunscreen, sneakers, boots, shorts, t-shirts, etc.) Be prepared to get dirty! NO OPEN TOED SHOES!

Please dress your child comfortably and appropriately for outdoor adventure. No sandals! Bug spray and a hat are suggested as we will be using the nature trails and Hike and Bike trail to access fishing areas. **Be sure to bring plenty of beverages in a refillable container!**
