WHAT WE DO

Gigi's Playhouse in Hillsborough is a special needs community center that was founded by a parent whose child has Down Syndrome. We make a lifetime commitment to offer support from birth through adulthood for individuals with special needs and their families.

We offer FREE adaptive programming for children, teens, and adults who have any kind of special needs. As a community center we also offer FREE inclusive programming, parent training, parent and child classes, tutoring, and special events!

We hold our programs mostly on the weekends or after school into evening hours.

For children under 13 the parent/guardians stay in the playhouse but can spend this time talking to and learning from one another while their children participate in programming. We also offer parent assisted classes where parent/guardians learn and play alongside their children.

For ages 13 and older we offer drop off programs where teens and young adults can join us for a program and parents/guardians get some time to themselves.
