C. Grade 5 students who have completed Holt Course 1 will have the following option based on placement criteria.
- Holt Course 2
D. Grade 6 students who have completed Holt Course 1 will have the following option based on placement criteria.
- Holt Course 2
E. Grade 6 students who have completed Holt Course 2 will have the following option based on placement criteria. - Pre-Algebra

A course level of curriculum can only be skipped after Grade 4 or Grade 5.
Students who would like to move into a different level may take an Exit Test. This test needs to be completed by the end of the third week of the new school year.

Since there is a great deal of testing in the math department, we recommend students take only Math Finals, not mid-terms and finals. With the exception of Algebra. That procedure should follow the high school.
